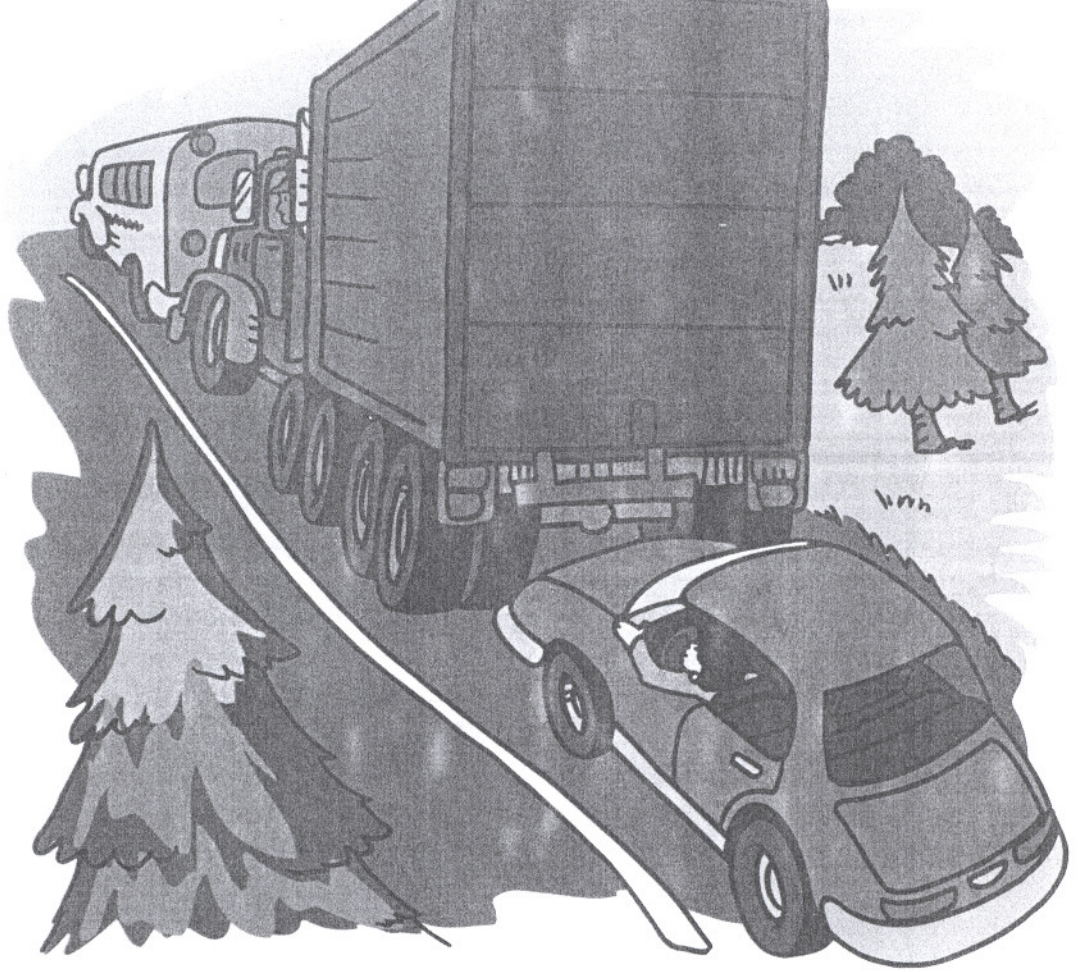
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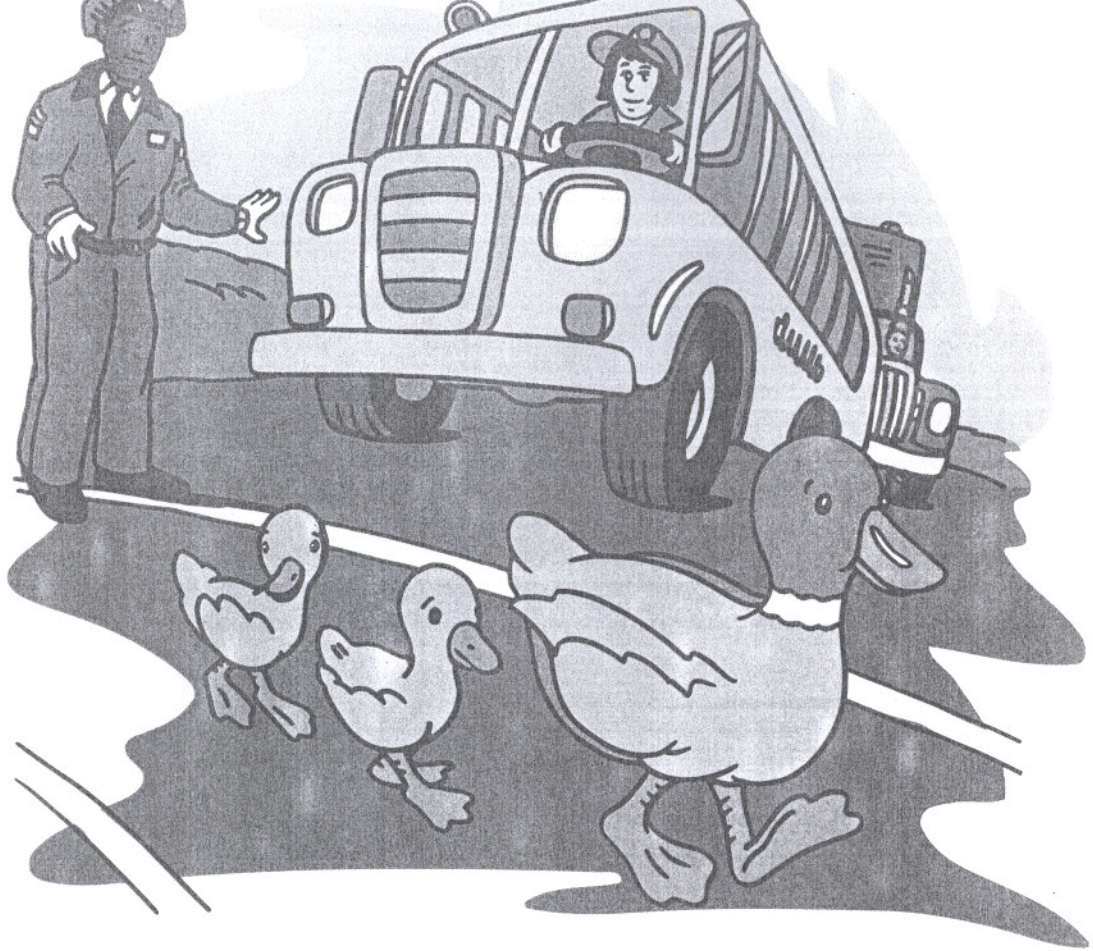
"Stop!" said the policeman.

said the car driver.



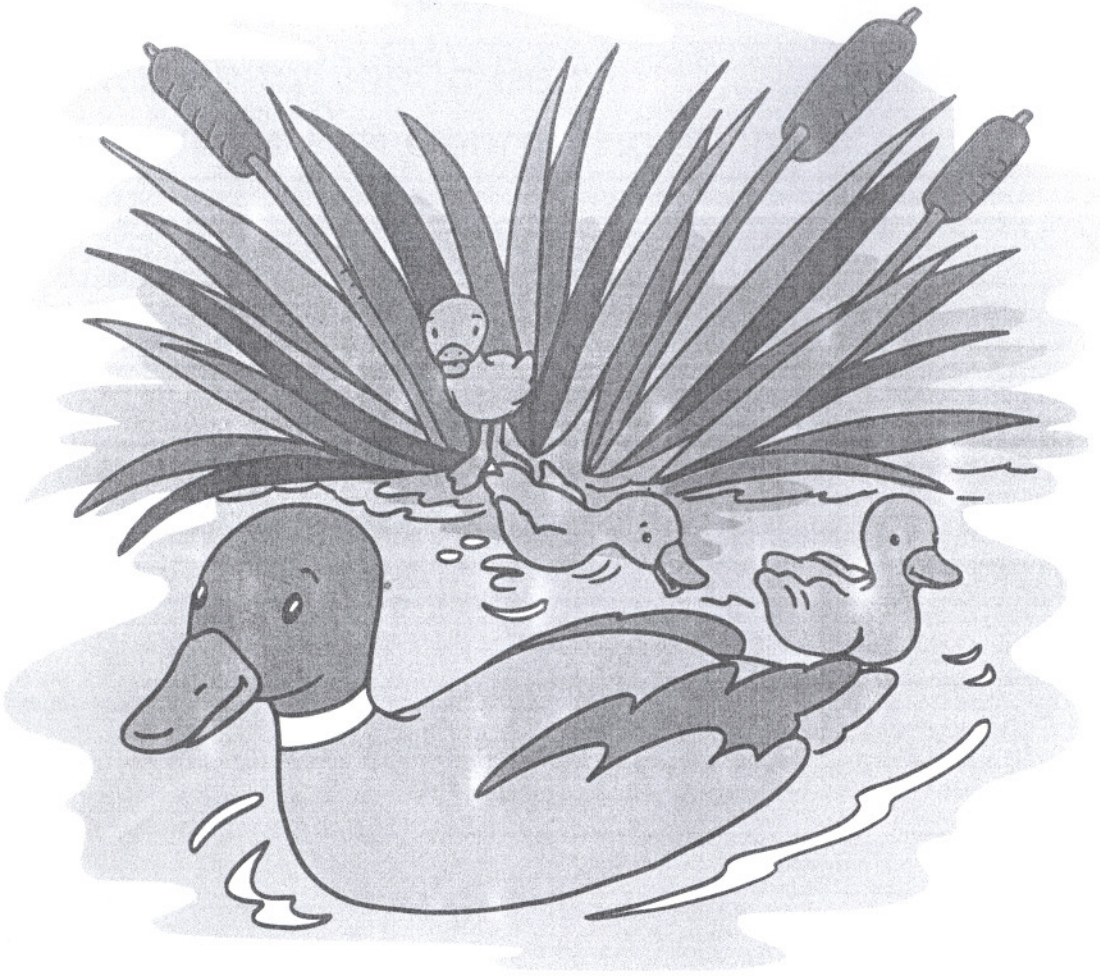
A mother duck and her babies

The truck and the car went on.



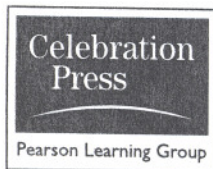
Then the mother duck and her babies
