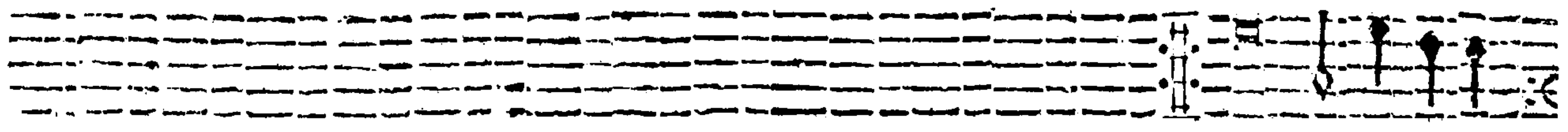


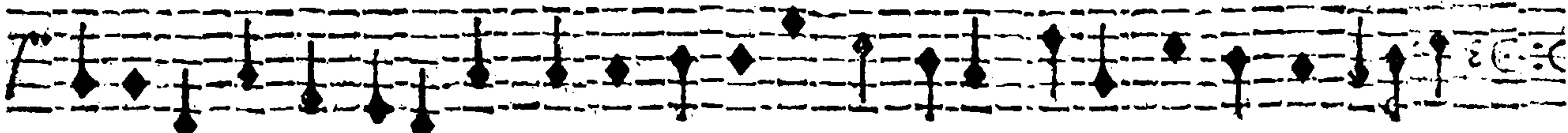

The tableture Base.
